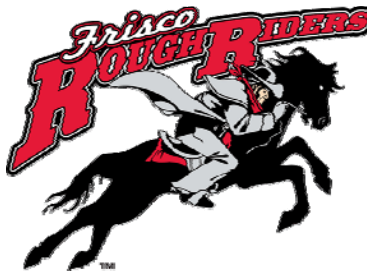

Down the Stretch They Come

With just five games remaining in the first half, the 'Riders hold a 3 1/2 game lead over Midland. Following their four game set with the Hooks, Frisco will finish the first half with three games at Midland. The 'Riders have not won an outright title in any half since their championship season in 2004.

Late Inning Lockdown

For the season, when the 'Riders are leading after eight innings, they are an outstanding 34-1. The bullpen has been a big part of this, with Jesse Ingram ranking third overall in the Texas League with 13 saves.

Aces Wild

Thanks to another strong outing on Thursday, in which he allowed only one run over six innings, Eric Hurley has now lowered his ERA to 2.55, good for second overall in the Texas League. After picking up the win, Hurley now is tied for the league lead in wins with seven. His 73 strikeouts are also good for second in the league, behind only last year's #1 pick overall, Luke Hochevar of Wichita with 79.

Doubling Up

After hitting two doubles on Thursday, Steve Murphy has a ten hitting streak coming into tonight's contest. During his run, Murphy has had multi-hit games in seven of the ten contests. He is 19-42 (.452) with 5 2B, 1 HR and 10 RBI over that stretch.

Sly Fox

In 2007, Adam Fox is posting a team high .336 batting average. In his last 10 games, Fox is also leading the team with a .484 average (15-31), with 3 2B, 2 HR and 7 RBI.

Doug Mathis (6-3, 3.23)

Last Two Starts

Midland (6/10) - Earned a no decision after getting roughed up in what was his toughest appearance of the season...gave up eight runs on twelve hits in just 4 1/3 innings...surrendered two home runs, the most he's given up this season...his 4 1/3 innings pitched was his shortest outing of the year.

San Antonio (6/5) - Picked up his sixth win of the season, scattering one run on four hits in seven strong innings of work...walked one and struck out three.

Mathis has been outstanding against Corpus Christi this year, going 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA in 13 innings. His best start of the season came against the Hooks on May 9 in Frisco, when Mathis threw seven innings of shutout ball allowing only one hit.

Overall on the season for Frisco, Mathis is 6-3. On the road, he has a 2.61 ERA compared to a 3.86 at home.
